



Rules and Regulations for Hope Township Cemeteries

SUMMARY OF CEMETERY RULES AS SET FORTH IN ORDINANCE NO. 22 and as amended.

All stones to be placed at head, west side of lot.

All foundations are to be installed by the Sexton or someone authorized by Sexton.

No flowers, shrubs, trees or other vegetation shall be planted except in urns on a foundation.

All artificial flowers and wreaths must be removed by April 1 with new to be installed after April 15.

Mounds, fencing, curbs, walls or similar structures that hinder mowing are prohibited.

The Township reserves the right to trim or removed any tree, plant or shrub.

The Cemetery Sexton shall have the right and authority to remove any and all growth, emblems, displays or containers therefore that through decay, deterioration, damage or otherwise become unsightly, a source of litter, or a maintenance problem.

No individual may sell cemetery space directly to another individual. Lessee may transfer a cemetery lot or space to the Township. The Township will pay the original purchase price.

Burial Vault and Casket are required.

Parking permitted in cemetery for cemetery workers use only. All other vehicles may be towed at owner's expense.
